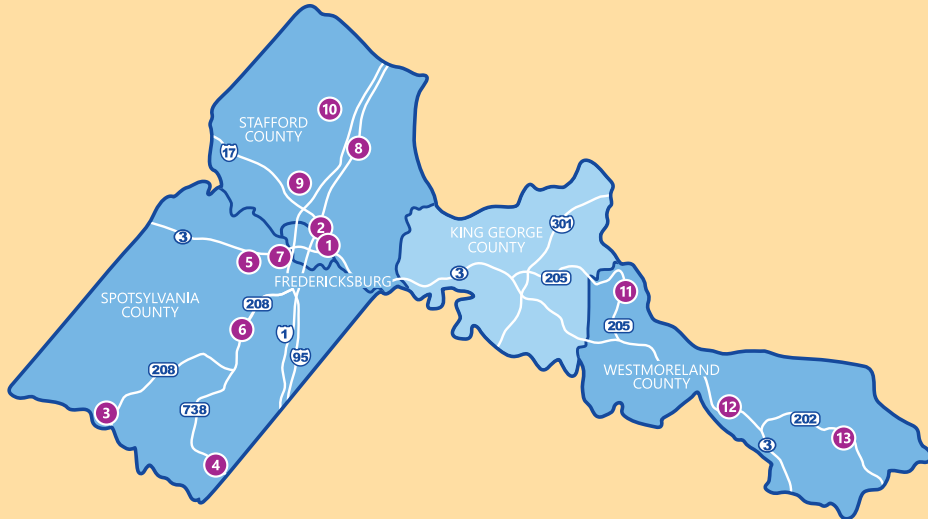

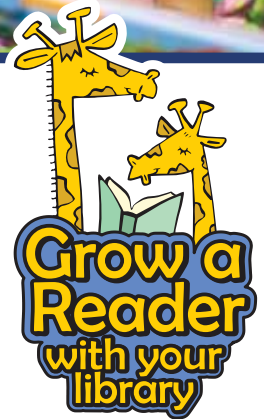

Claudia Emerson Teen Poetry Contest

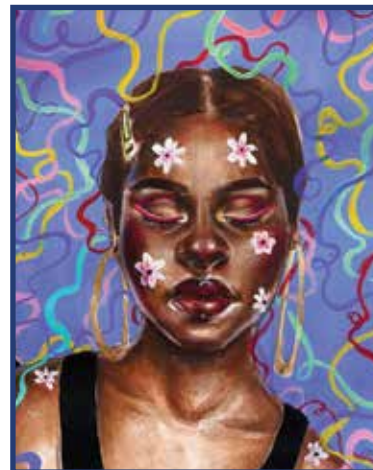
