

Spotlight on Early Literacy: Print Awareness

We are surrounded by printed words. We use them daily to navigate and communicate. Helping our little ones recognize that print has meaning and represents something real in the world is called Print Awareness and is a critical skill in helping children get ready to read.

Tips for raising print awareness:

- Run your finger under printed words as you read them to your child, wherever you see them (in books, or even cereal boxes!) This will draw your child's eyes to the print.
- Whenever you see your child's name written, point it out to them. They will quickly learn that this word represents them.






