Director's Goals: Accomplishments December-February



Public Relations:

- I am speaking to a Chamber Leadership Fredericksburg class in April
- We purchased and distributed 887 copies of Rachel's Dream, by Ruth Coder Fitzgerald, to Fredericksburg City Schools' middle school students
- We received support from the local chapter of the NAACP to cover the book costs for Rachel's Dream
- Completed two-year term as Chair of the Rappahannock Goodwill Industries Board of Directors; I remain on the Board
- Continued service on Topside FCU Board of Directors
- Continued service on the Chamber's Board of Directors



Organizational Development:

- Continued focus and emphasis on three main themes derived from the Employee Survey (Compensation, Autonomy, and Stress)
- Continued attending Public Library Association Leadership Development Committee meetings
- Several staff and I attended the annual Chamber's CNEW luncheon in December
- Several staff positions were recently filled
- Purchased and scheduled installation of two picnic tables for the Montross Park, using bequest funds
- Plans are progressing on a storywalk for the Montross Park, also using bequest funds
- Westmoreland Library on the Go vehicle retrofitting is in progress



Library Administration:

- Work continues on a lease extension with Cafaro Companies and Spotsylvania County for the Towne Centre Branch
- CRRL distributed 5,169 free COVID test kits from the VDH
- Met with the new Westmoreland County Administrator
- We returned to a quarterly printing of our magazine, @Your Library, beginning with the Spring edition; this saves staff time and printing expenses



Financial Management:

- Met with the auditor regarding the FY23 audit
- CRRL received a \$7,500 grant from the Fredericksburg Charitable Foundation to expand our ESL resources
- CRRL also received an additional \$7,500 Duff McDuff Green, Jr. Fund grant for our Library on the Go initiative
- Wegmans is helping to sponsor our Youth Services Summer Reading Program for \$2,000
- TAL Tea Time is also sponsoring our Youth Services Summer Reading Program for \$1,000

- Conducted Board training for new Westmoreland Board member
- Met with Board Chair to review the March meeting agenda
- Scheduling welcome back and board training for returning Spotsylvania Board member








Adult Winter Reading Challenge

From January 1 through March 31, adults who read and log 5 books earn a colorful stylus pen.






Library Speakers Consortium Author Talks

Kindergarten Library Card Campaign


Between January 16 and February 21, families of area kindergarten students received invitations to apply for library cards, either via a printed hand-out or by email.




Community Read/Watch
