Teen Art Show Rules

- All work must be original interpretations by the artist. No copies please. We cannot use pieces hung at the library in previous years.
- An entrant may submit no more than two pieces.
- All work will be accepted contingent on being reviewed by the installation committee. The library reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- While we make every effort to care for your art, the library is not responsible for the damage or loss of any work.
- Entries may not be picked up before May 1. Work must be picked up May 2-16 from the Youth Services Desk at the Fredericksburg Branch, unless you wish to donate your work to Loisann's Hope House.*
- Entries may be submitted by students living in the City of Fredericksburg, the counties of Stafford, Spotsylvania, or Westmoreland, or by any other teen who holds a library card from Central Rappahannock Regional Library.

Framing Guidelines

- All work must be framed OR painted canvas on stretcher strips OR mounted on foam core and shrink-wrapped (no plastic wrap please).
- We cannot accept three-dimensional, freestanding work.
- Foam core with acetate or shrink-wrap is the least expensive option.
- Minimum matted or framed size is 11" x 14".
- No gallery clips, plastic frames, or picture frames with easel supports/stands.

To Enter:

Entries accepted February 17-27.

Bring artwork to the Youth Services Desk at the Fredericksburg Branch, 1201 Caroline Street, Fredericksburg.

Local artists will judge the Grades 11-12 category prior to the opening. Participants in Grades 11-12 will judge the Grades 9-10 category at the opening reception on Friday, March 1, between 7:00-8:30.
